
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How can occupational diseases be prevented?

Occupational disease prevention can be done. to keep operators safe from potential dangers while working This can be prevented as follows:









Learn the hazards in the workplace. to find a way to protect operators from that danger






Employers should develop safety systems, programs, requirements and procedures. Designed to protect workers in the workplace from injury or illness. and employees should follow



Communicate health hazards and risks to employees. provide appropriate information and training to educate the operators in order to be able to protect themselves from basic dangers



work with health professionals to investigate an injury or illness with any indication that it may be work-related, such as telling health professionals where they work, what work they do, and about what products To know the risk factors that may affect the health of workers.
