Accidents are usually caused by 3



### SITUATIONS OR TOOLS

Eequipment that are unsafe (hard ware) such as machinery or equipment is damaged. Hazardous work areas or areas









### unsafe working methods

Unsafe work methods (soft ware), such as no work procedures, no WI





### PERSON NEGLIGENCE

Person negligence (human ware) Employees are not careful. Working with negligence, taking risks, not following rules, etc. Human ware accidents caused by unsafe actions are the leading cause of accidents, accounting for 85% of all accidents. Unsafe actions include:






- Working across steps or shortcuts
- Negligence, carelessness, absent-mindedness
- having a propensity to take risks or deliberate avoidance for convenience
- Failure to comply with safety regulations at work
- Work without wearing PPE personal protective equipment
- Using improper or wrong type of tools, modifying or converting tools, machines
- Working with abnormal physical or mental conditions not
- ready to work

- Work with haste, haste, etc.
