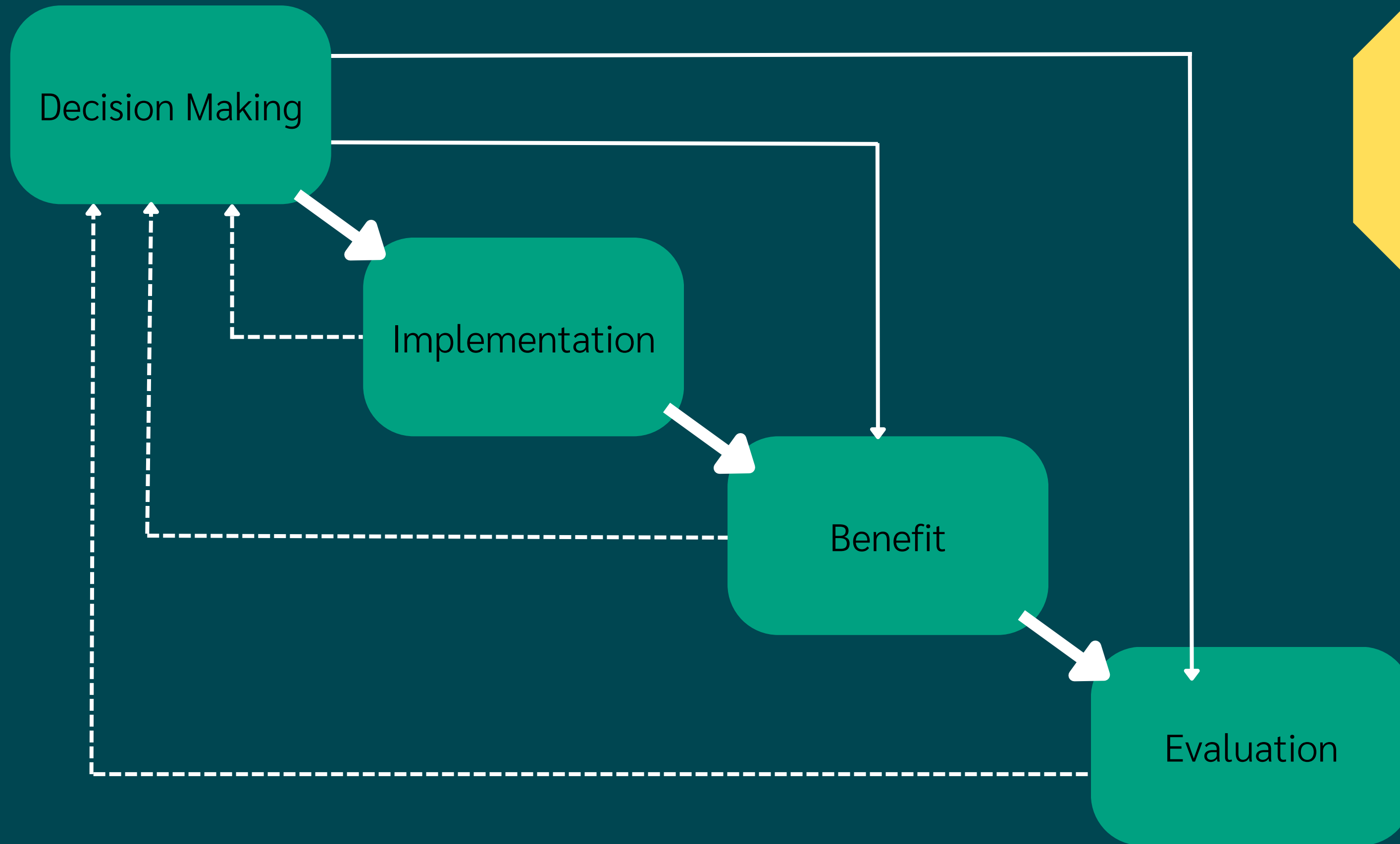


Participation

Participation means that community members must participate in four aspects:

- 1) participate in deciding what to do and what to do.
- 2) Participate in the sacrifice in the development, including the implementation of decisions
- 3) participate in the sharing of benefits generated by the operation.
- 4) Participate in project evaluation

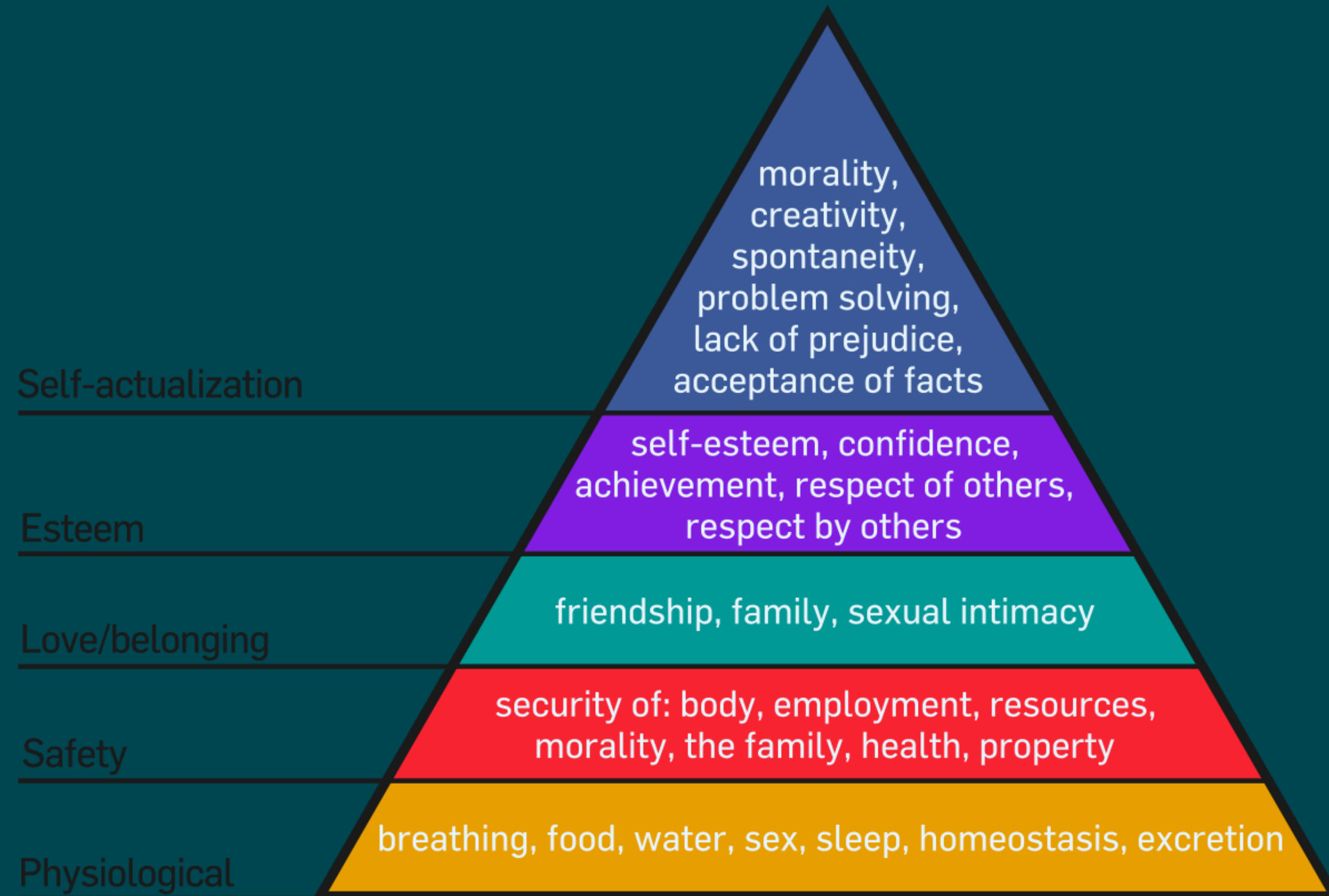
