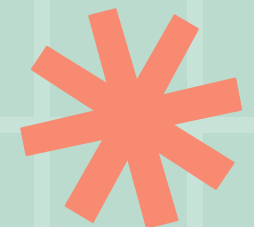




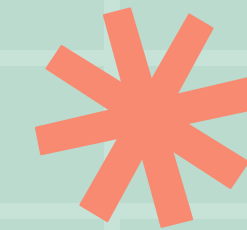
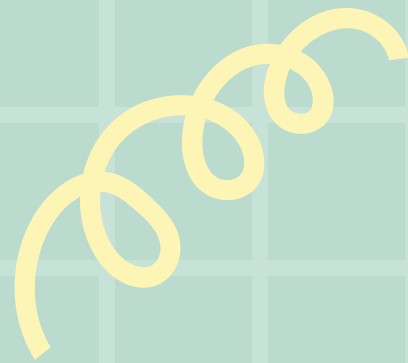

HEALTH SYSTEM MANAGEMENT MODEL

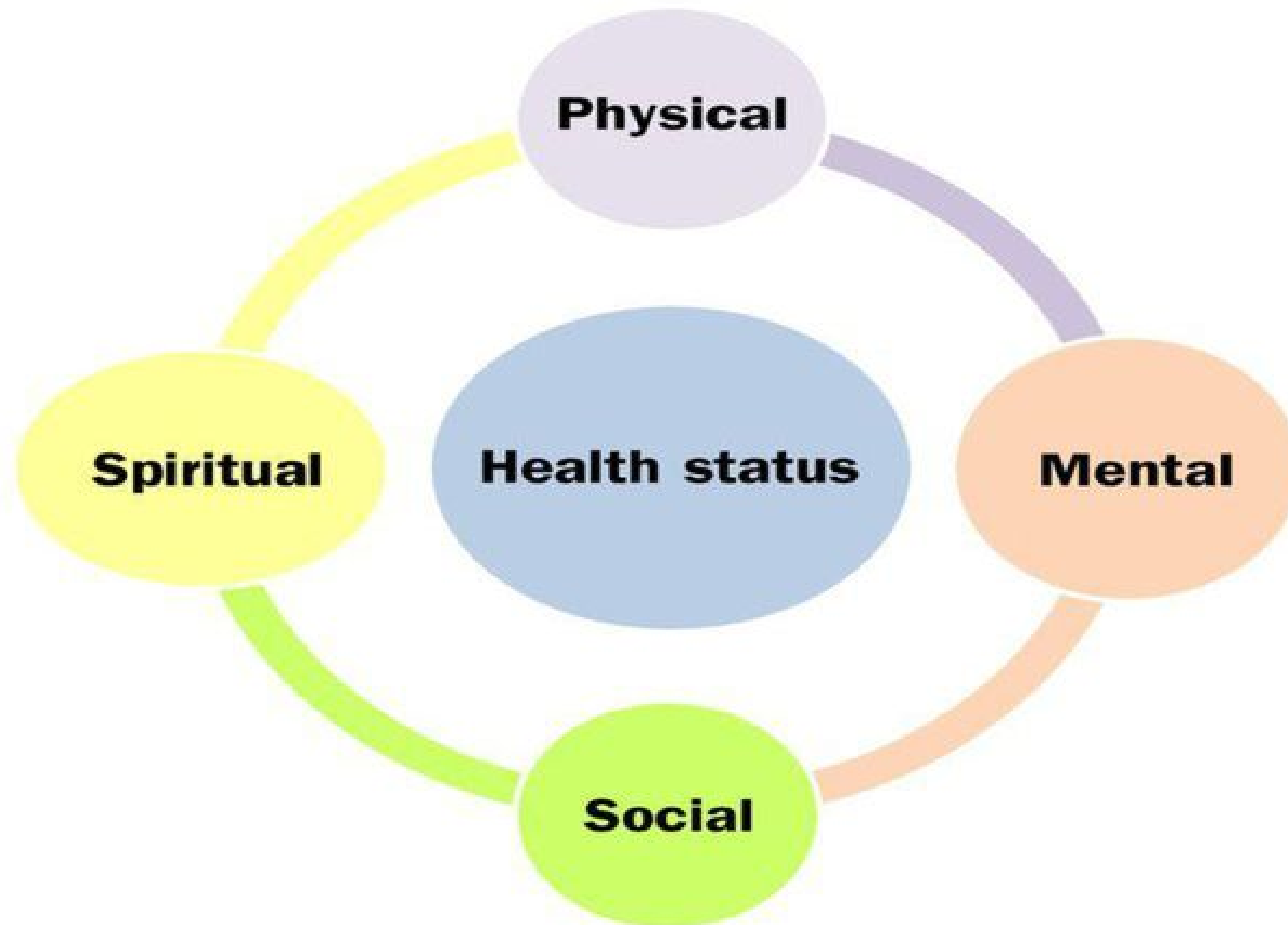


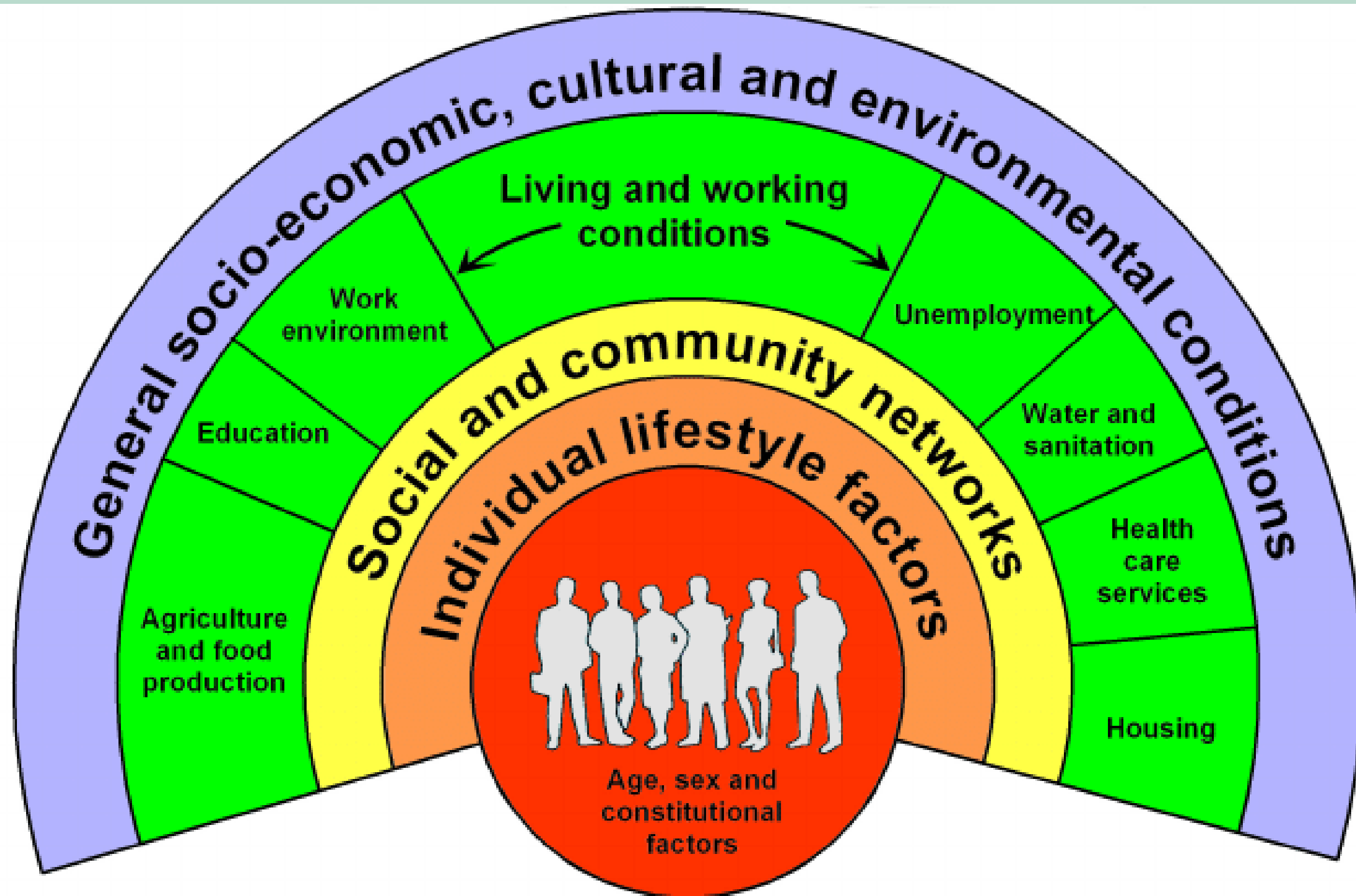

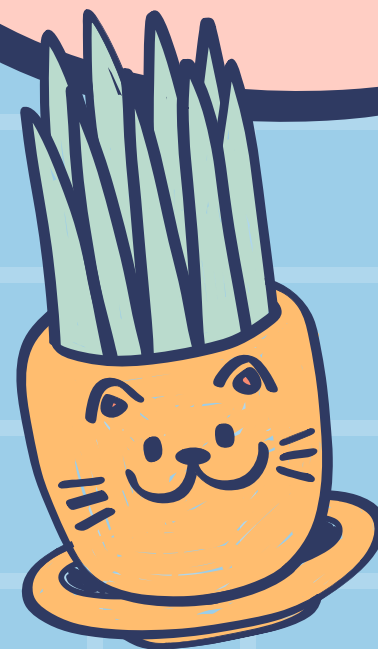
